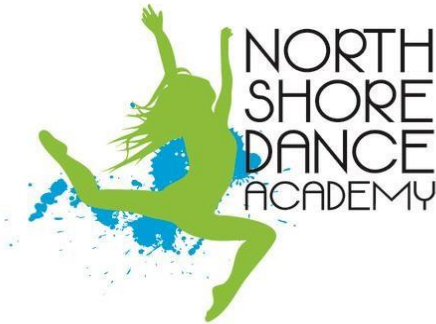

What programs does North Shore Dance Academy offer?

Recreational classical dance program:

A great program for students who love to dance and meet new friends while enjoying many other extracurricular activities as well.

Ages 3-7: Tap/Ballet Combination class. Offered one hour a week. ½ hour per subject. Students wear white tap shoes, pink ballet slippers and a leotard and tights any style or color

Ages 7-12: Tap/Ballet/Jazz Combination classes. Offered 1.5 hours a week ½ hour Per Subject.

Students wear Tan tap shoes, pink ballet slippers, tan jazz shoes and a leotard and tights any style or color (form fitting shorts may be added for tap and jazz class)

Middle School Tap/Ballet/Jazz/Lyrical. Same attire as above. Classes expand in time gradually to accommodate more skill.

High School Tap/Ballet/Jazz/Lyrical: These classes are an hour long and can be taken alone or together depending on the desires of the student.

Dancer Within Program

Dance is for everyone! We have a wonderful program for children that may be differently abled. Our Dancer Within program is going into the fifth year and the students in it have become best friends and have had great progress while having a blast. This is a one on one class. Each dancer has a buddy. If you know anyone that may benefit from this class please give them this information.

Adult Program

Dance is not just for kids! We have an adult program as well. When this program was designed over 10 years ago it was really just a hope that some of our dance moms might be able to have a night out and do something for themselves. Over 10 years later much has changed! The program grew, not to just our dance moms but to women and men all over the community who wanted to dance. Either to continue what they learned as a child or to start brand new with something they always wanted to do. Our adult program consists of Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced Tap, as well as Ballet, Jazz and Zumba classes. There is even opportunity to perform.

Hip Hop:

We offer a large Hip hop program for dancers at NSDA. They may choose to take these classes alone or in addition to their classical dance program. These classes are divided by age groups. The attire is comfortable clothes that they can work out in (protecting knees from floor work) and sneakers that will only be worn inside the dance classroom.

Intensive Program:

This program is designed for serious students who have committed to making dance their #1 extra-curricular activity. Multiple classes and genres are required for these dancers and a pre-requisite experience and NSDA summer Program must be met in order to be a part of this program. Call for more details

NSDA Goodwill Ambassador Performance Troop:

NSDA dancers age 5-18 that would like to volunteer to perform throughout the community make up this wonderful troop. We perform at least once a month and after the show has been established we have one monthly rehearsal. If you would like to be a part of this troop please let us know at registration. Rehearsals for the 2018-2019 year will start in August 2018.

NSDA Recreational Program Pricing

All tuition is withdrawn from the checking account or credit card of your choice on the 1st of each month September- May. It is your responsibility to keep your payment information current with us. Payments are made electronically based on the information you provide on your registration form.

NSDA tuition is based on a full year of instruction broken up in to 9 monthly installments for your convenience. Each installment is the same amount regardless of how many lessons are offered during that particular month.

There are 32 days of instruction however tuition is based on a 30-week payment schedule. 2 extra days are built into the schedule to accommodate for closure due to inclement weather. If no cancellations have been made you can consider those two extra classes "on the house". No refunds are given due to a student's missed classes. Please feel free to attend a makeup in a similar level class.

This tuition structure reflects a \$1 per hour of class instruction increase from the previous season and is set for the 2018-2019 **AND** 2019-2020 Dance seasons. If you choose to pay the year in full your \$30 registration fee is waived.
